A NEW GENERATION

The next level in Aglaonema evolution has been created at the UF Mid Atlantic Research Center in the heart of Florida. Aglaonema breeder, Dr. Jake Henny, has developed a new line of Aglaonemas that out perform his original creation, Silver Bay. This new line is The Bay Collection™, which has such superior varieties that the University of Florida has patented them!

CLEAN STOCK

The Bay Collection™ Aglaonemas are transported to a commercial tissue culture laboratory where they are put into propagation for starter plants. These starter plants make up the sterile benched stock that provides Kraft Gardens with nematode-free cuttings.

If you have ever had an Aglaonema die while others survive in the same environment, it is probably not your fault. It is most likely nematodes.

NEMATODES

Many mass-produced Aglaonemas (i.e. Silver Bay, Silver Queen & Maria) are grown in stock fields. These stock fields are contaminated with nematodes, which are micro-organisms responsible for destroying roots.

Lynn Griffin, owner of A & L Laboratories, who has consulted for Aglaonema stock farms all over the Caribbean, Central America, and parts of Africa has said, "I have never seen an Aglaonema cutting farm that was not infested with nematodes".

GROWING PROCESS

The Bay Collection™ Aglaonemas from Kraft Gardens are nematode-free. The same sanitation process that begins with sterile stock plants and cuttings perseveres through the growing practices at Kraft Gardens. All production areas are sanitized before new stock is laid out. All the components involved in The Bay Collection™ production such as soil, pots and benches are sterilized before use.

This creates a perfect environment for vigorous roots to form. In fact, the root systems become so strong that it prevents complications due to over-watering.

Kraft Gardens' attention to detail in the growing process of The Bay Collection™ creates products that are the most durable Aglaonemas on the market today, earning them the right to be called Professional Grade Plants™.

Care Instructions

LIGHT: 50 to 1000 ft candles. Preferred 100 to 250 ft. candles

WATER: Keep evenly moist. Water about once per week. If under watered older leaves will turn yellow.

FERTILIZER: Three times per year with 1 teaspoon of 20-20-20 per gallon of water.

TEMPERATURE: Tolerates as low as 45°, prefers 70° - 75° F.
