FICUS LYRATA™ Column are grown in our State-of-the-Art shade-houses. These shade-houses have dual moving shade curtains that control light, humidity, and temperature, creating a stress free environment. The moving shade systems provide ideal lighting for acclimatization resulting in tighter leaf internodes and firmer stems.

FICUS LYRATA Column is grown from a single standard tissue culture rather than clump Lyrata tissue cultures. Three individual standard Lyratas are selected, matched then potted.

FICUS LYRATA Column is continuously grown and fed with our computerized fertigation drip system, which gives the plant clean glossy leaves so you have minimum cleaning before putting them on the job. This superior production method allows the Lyrata more space for air circulation and light penetration resulting in a Lyrata Column that holds its leaves even in the center of the plant.

FICUS LYRATA Column has a columnar appearance with uniform leaf size from the top to the bottom. Our growers sanitize their clippers to insure that no disease is ever transmitted between plants. A special soil is blended for Kraft Gardens, using the finest ingredients. Our growers check the soil daily for moisture and fertilizer content. This information is then programmed into a computer to deliver just the right amount of each. TM

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

LIGHT: 200 to 2000 ft candles, diffused light, near window.

WATER: Keep soil moist, do not let soil dry out. Water weekly as needed.

FERTILIZE: Fertilize three times a year using 2 tsp. soluble 20-10-20 per gallon, along with 1 tsp magnesium sulfate and 1/4 tsp manganese sulfate.

TEMPERATURE: 62° - 80°F is ideal.

TRIM: Trim to maintain shape. Cut after leaf internode.

Lyrata Column Facts

FICUS LYRATA is commonly called the Fiddle Leaf Fig due to its violin-shaped leaves. Before tissue culture propagation, air layering stock farms propagated Ficus Lyrata. Now the best production is derived from tissue culture. Tissue culture has made Ficus Lyrata more compact with smaller leaf size, enabling small pot sizes to be

produced today. Ficus Lyrata sometimes have red spots on the leaves, which can be caused from disease. This discoloration may also be from insects, wind damage,

or physical damage due to improper handling. Mites or Aphids will sometimes attack the soft new growth, but will leave the older thick leaves alone. TM
