Care Instructions

LIGHT: 75 to 150 ft candles. A northern window without direct sunlight is popular. Prefers 40 to 60% relative humidity.

WATER: Keep soil evenly moist, but do not over water.

FERTILIZE: Four times per year with 1 teaspoon of water soluble 20-20-20 per gallon of water.

TEMPERATURE: 65° to 85° Ideal 75°.

Kraft Gardens grows Chamaedorea Palms from seeds germinated in a special chamber 12 months out of the year. **1**

As these seeds sprout, they are placed in a separate cell and grown as individuals for eight months before they are hand selected and planted. **2**

Kraft Gardens was the first to perfect using individual seedlings planted evenly in the container rather than clumping dozens of plants in the middle of the container. **3**

This growing process allows a natural progression of growth. The individual palms grow without competing with one another allowing the palm to mature equally and gain thick caliper trunks. **4**

As the palms mature, natural sucker sprout from the base of each individual palm creating a balance of height, shape and fullness. **5**

The natural balance of Kraft's Chamaedoreas is what makes them so durable in the interior. Light is filtered down through the canopy keeping the plant

fuller top to bottom. Couple this growing process with a state-of-the-art moving shade house, liquid feed drip irrigation system, and the finest soil available. **6**
