Growing Media

Hawaiian growers mix approximately 30% quality Canadian peat moss with volcanic cinder and other ingredients for optimum pH and nutrition. Cinder is created when volcanoes explode and mix with air creating a very porous inert ingredient. Cinder has water-holding capacity as well as good aeration. This mixture resists over-watering even in low light. It decomposes slowly, providing a long-term, durable potting mix.

SPECIAL CARE INSTRUCTIONS

LIGHT: Can tolerate light as low as 50 to 75ft candles. 250 to 300 ft candles preferred..

TEMPERATURE: 50° to 72°.

FERTILIZER: 2 or 3 times a year using a liquid feed, preferably with a little iron once in a while. It is best not to feed in winter.

WATER: Hawaiian Rhapsis have large root systems and displace soil in the container, thus reducing the water holding capacity. More frequent watering is preferred. Do not let it go completely dry or leaf tipping will occur. **Checking moisture:** simply scrape back the surface of the media. If moisture is present it does not need to be watered until the following week. Add water evenly around the entire surface for uniform watering. Try to use water low in fluorides.
